





CULTURE OFTAMIL NADU

Tamil Nadu is a major centre for music, arts, dance and literature in India with Chennai being the cultural capital. From classical dance forms like Bharatanatvam that originated in Tamil Nadu to other regional folk dances including Karakattam, Kavadi, Koodiyattam, Oyilattam, Paraiattam and Puravaiattam, Tamil Nadu boasts of a rich repertoire of dance forms. In addition to dance, the traditional music of Tamil Nadu known as Carnatic music, and other forms of instrumental folk music such as Koothu, Parai, Tharai, Yazh and Murasu form part of Tamil Nadu's musical tapestry. Tamil Nadu has an independent literary tradition dating back over 2500 years from the Sangam era. From the Tolkappiyam, the epics Silappatikaram, Manimekalai, Tirukkural, to the 19th century writings and poems by authors such as Meenakshi Sundaram Pillai, U.V. Swaminatha Iyer, Ramalinga Swamigal, Maraimalai Adigal, Subramania Bharati and Bharathidasan
